CRIME & PUNISHMENT

Summer Term 2 2023

This term, we are learning about crimes and the punishments associated with them, since the Roman Empire to the present day.



Writing

We will be producing pieces of writing based on our historical topic this term. We will write from the point of view of a criminal and hold an upper school debate about appropriate punishments for crimes, accompanied by a discussion text.

Music

RE
